

Dear Parishioners,

Praise the Lord! It is my honor to share with you our parish's Annual Report. What a year it has been! This is my first time composing an Annual Report, so I will do my best to provide a snapshot of various aspects of our parish community from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

But let's jump back to earlier in 2023. As you know, the parish experienced much change last year. Fr. Greg Oslzewski joined St. Joseph's as a Parochial Vicar in March 2023. He hit the ground running and has made himself right at home here. Speaking of running, Fr. Kevin Klonowski finished his assignment at St. Joseph's in June 2023 and began doctoral studies in Rome, focusing on Sacred Scripture. It took some time for Fr. Kevin to adjust to life in Italy, but he has settled in and is excelling in his studies. Fr. Joe Mamich was named the Diocesan Vicar for Clergy in 2023, which was an unexpected change for the parish. Fr. Joe would not be able to wear both hats as Pastor of St. Joseph's *and* be the Vicar for Clergy. So, after 12 great years as Pastor, he said farewell to the parish. Until a new Pastor was named, Fr. Joe remained the temporary Administrator. In the interim, the parish learned

that another Parochial Vicar would be coming to Strongsville from the Philippines. Fr. Arnulfo "Arnold" Tiplaca joined the parish in November 2023, and he was warmly welcomed by everyone. It was also around that time that Bishop Malesic named me as the new Administrator of St. Joseph's! Praise the Lord! Fr. Joe began to bring me onboard in December 2023, and I officially started on January 15th, 2024. I cannot thank you enough for the welcome and reception you have provided since

I began! Your prayers, love, and support have been so amazing, and I am blessed to be the Administrator of such a wonderful parish family!

2024 has been an action-packed year for us. Lent began quickly after I arrived, and we were able to bring six people into the Church at the Easter Vigil. As a way to learn more about St. Joseph's, we gathered to share what we love about the parish, as well as our hopes and dreams for the future. These *History & Hopes* sessions generated fond memories from the past and inspiring visions for what lies ahead. I am so excited to be here as your shepherd, and I am looking forward to journeying with all of you on the road to becoming saints!

Looking at the financial picture of St. Joseph's, you will notice throughout the next two pages that we managed to finish the year with a surplus of over \$150,000. This is due to many of the parish disbursements being down. At the same time, while offertory collections were down slightly compared to 2022, the market has been on our side. This has helped to offset the difference for the better. When planning for the 2024-2025 fiscal year, we budgeted conservatively, entrusting to God our efforts and trusting that His Providence will guide us.

In conclusion, I want to repeat how grateful I am for each and every one of you at St. Joseph's. And thank you for being a member of this parish family. This is truly a blessed parish, and we pray that the Lord continues to bless us so that we may keep serving God and neighbor as we have been doing since 1946.
