- Major improvements: \$ 37,240 in 2022; door to drain 60% school, 40% parish, tractor and market loss 77k. 2019 2,835 families, 2021 2,603 families.
- Since 2019 we are still doing well.
- Had a 30% gas bills budgeted increase.
- We are in good financial shape because of the generosity of the parishioners.

Open Forum:

- Time Capsule, Father Joe will invite families to participate at a later date.
- There is an error if you search St. Joe's Strongsville online. Father Joe will look into this.
- A discussion followed about the current activity within the parish being posted on the current signs in the front of the church to update the parishioners.
